WHAT ARE THE CURRENT TRENDS IN THE SAUDI POWER MARKET?

WB: The current trend taking place right now is an increased focus on the government's deployment of energy efficiency and renewable energy in the Kingdom. The infrastructure sector in Saudi Arabia is on the verge of huge expansions, which is expected to provide a big thrust to power sector.



WHAT ARE THE MAJOR CHALLENGES FACED IN THE GCC POWER SECTOR?

WB: Most GCC Countries are on an average scale in terms of a favourable business climate and entry barriers. The GCC as a whole is expected to witness strong economic and demographic growth in the near future which would lead to increased demand for electricity. The population of GCC nations is expected to grow at an annual rate of 2,5%. The per capita consumption of electricity in GCC is higher than the global average.

WHAT PROGRESSIVE TRENDS HAVE YOU SEEN THAT SAUDI ARABIA NEEDS TO ADOPT?

WB: Modernization of the power infrastructure by governments in the region is the main key driver supporting that will support growth in KSA. There are very large expenses for utilities, so it is usually difficult to cover this load, therefore there needs to be more efficiency in the way we use electricity. We need to think and act smarter
